TOIPIC FHOGHLAMA

Rang 1

Tá Rang 1 ag dul don topaic *Mé Féin agus Mo Theaghlach* an leath-théarma seo. Tá na páistí ag foghlaim fúthú féin, faoin chorp agus faoina dteaghlaigh le linn na topaice seo.

Rang 2

Tá páistí Rang 2 ag fiosrú fosta, ag leibhéal níos forbartha, faoin topic *Mé Féin agus Mo Theaghlach* an leath-théarma seo. Tá siad ag foghlaim faoin chorp agus tá siad ag fiosrú na gcúig cheadfa. Amharcaidh siad ar na dóigheanna arbh fhéidir leo a gcorp a choinneail sláintiúil.

Ranganna 3 /4

Tá Rang 3 ag dul don topaic *Is Maith Linn an Scoil!* Tá siad ag foghlaim faoi chineáil éagsúla scoileanna atá ann sa tír seo agus i dtíortha eile. Cuirfear suirbhé amach chuig Mamó agus Daideo ag fiosrú scoileanna mar a bhíodh. Tá na páistí ag foghlaim faoina gceantar féin fosta.

Rang 5

Beidh Rang 5 ag foghlaim faoi *Muintearas agus Mé Féin* an leath-théarma seo. Tá siad ag foghlaim faoi *mé féin*, na céadfaí, mise mar chuid den phobal agus faoina gceantar féin. Mar chuid den fhoghlaim faoi na céadfaí, beidh na páistí ag foghlaim an aibítir i dteanga chomharthaíochta na hÉireann fosta.

Rang 6

Tá páistí Rang 6 ag foghlaim faoin *Eitilt*. Mar chuid den tóipic, tá siad ag amharc ar na héin, an nadúr, cúrsaí teicneolaíochta agus an dóigh a mbíonn eitleáin san aer. Gheobhaidh siad amach faoi dhaoine cailúla cosúil leis the Wright Brothers agus Amelia Earhart. Tá e-leathannach *Fronter* ag na páistí chun cuidiú agus chun cuir leis an fhoghlaim.

Rang 7

Is í An Fheirmeoireacht toipic fhoghhlama páistí Rang 7 an leath-théarma seo. Tá na páistí ag foghlaim faoi bharr éagsúla agus faoi ainmhithe feirme in Éirinn agus i dtíortha eile. Tá siad ag foghlaim fosta faoi innealra feirme.

LEARNING TOPICS

Please read below the various learning topics children are learning about in Term 1a.

Rang 1

Rang 1 are investigating the topic *Myself and My Family* this term. The children are learning about themselves, their body parts and their families during this topic.

Rang 2

This half-term the children in Rang 2 are also investigating, at a more developed level, the topic of *Myself and My Family*. They are learning about the body and are investigating the senses. They will also look at ways in which they can keep their bodies healthy.

Ranganna 3/4

Children in Rang 3 are finding out about different kind of schools in this country and in other countries through the topic *We Like School!* A survey will be sent out to grandparents as part of their research into schools long ago. The children are also learning about where they live.

Rang 5

This half term, Rang 5 will be learning about *Being and Belonging*. They will be learning about *myself*, their senses, themselves as part of the community and about their own area. As part of learning about the senses, the children will also learn how to sign the alphabet in Irish Sign Language.

Rang 6

Rang 6 children are learning about the topic *Flight*. As part of the topic, they are looking at the birds, nature, technology and the way in which aeroplanes stay in the air. They will also learn about famous people in history associated with flight such as The Wright Brothers and Amelia Earhart. The children have an e-learning *Fronter* page to help and to encourage them with their learning.

Rang 7

Farming is the learning topic for children in Rang 7 this half-term. The children are learning about various crops and farm animals in Ireland and in other countries. They are also learning about farm machinery.
